What swiMark used to be...lots of forms to fill in, extra pressures on volunteers and lots of reinventing the wheel! A year ago only 6 clubs in Scotland had achieved swiMark, with very few signed up to go through the process.

A year on and 63 clubs across Scotland are actively working towards achieving swiMark clubs with 12 clubs now accredited.

So how has swiMark changed?

- ✓ On site support from your RSDM who will help club development plans and work to assist clubs to meet the swiMark criteria
- ✓ Club friendly swiMark USB with detailed breakdown of the criteria and a comprehensive set of templates and resources that will help develop the policies and procedures



- ✓ Support from trained personnel from local authorities & trusts and local aquatic forums sharing good practice
- ✓ Mapping to local authority accreditation scheme to avoid duplication
